A Little History

Blue Hills Ski Area is conveniently located in Canton, MA, making it the closest ski area to the Boston Metro Area. The Ski Area itself has been around since the early 1960's. The Department of Conservation & Recreation (DCR) of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts owns the ski area, which has been leased by numerous companies in the past. The revitalization began in 2007 when Ski Blue Hills Management, LLC (SBHM) was awarded a 5-year lease of the area. SBHM also operates Campgaw Mountain in Mahwah, NJ and is dedicated to bringing back Blue Hills Ski Area by creating an atmosphere where families come together to enjoy winter sports in a fun, safe environment.

Guests to Blue Hills Ski Area have spoken, and the staff has listened. New programs have been developed, and old programs have gotten a well-needed face-lift.

Debuting this upcoming season will be our **Mountain Adventure Programs**. After you have mastered our Learning Center, you can now make the next step to our multi week programs.

The **Vacation Camp** is for participants' ages 7-15 ski/ride with an instructor from 10:30am – 3:30pm each day. Unsupervised skiing/riding before and afterwards is included. These camps are a great opportunity to learn and improve at your winter sport while spending some quality time outdoors in a fun, friendly family environment during the weeks of Dec and Feb breaks.

Adult Programs

For women looking to stay active during the winter months, we are introducing the **“Women Rock” Program**. This 3 or 5-week program is designed for women looking to learn how to ski or improve their skiing ability. It is a women's only group setting to refine skills, build confidence, and enjoy the mountain in all conditions.

The **Munchkin Program** is a 5-week program for children ages 4-6 years old, 5-6 years old for Snowboarding. You pick the day of the week and the time and our highly trained staff will introduce the children to the ski equipment, maneuvering in the boots, balancing on one and two skis, sliding, and gliding. The program is designed to repeat and reinforce the fundamental skiing skills in a group setting.

Open to skiers/riders between the ages of 7-10 years old. The **Mountain Patroller Club** has been carefully designed for intermediate to advanced skiers/riders who will explore the mountain playground. Your child will work on developing and improving skiing skills. They will also visit the many areas of mountain operation including ski patrol, lift operations, and snowmaking.

The **Adult Slide ‘N’ Dine** program will be offered to all adult skiers from beginner to advanced in conjunction with some area restaurants/bars we have created a lift, lesson and/or rental package. On Tuesdays & Thursdays come alone to meet new friends or bring a group to share the fun followed by a light dinner at one of the participating restaurant/bars.

The **Junior Program** is a 1-½ hour lesson for 5 weeks for kids' ages 7-15 years old. This program honors the needs and goals of aspiring and accomplished skiers/riders who want more than the usual ski school lesson. It introduces basic and advanced skiing/riding concepts at all levels whether it is for recreational athletes or competitors.

Any participant enrolled in a program that wishes to continue with additional lessons can receive the same package originally purchased at a discounted rate per lesson booked. This gives the skier/rider a chance to keep improving their skills through the end of the season.

The **“Senior Gliders & Sliders” Program** will be offered to those wiser, more experienced skiers and riders interested in honing their skiing or boarding technique. The curriculum is designed toward the desires of the seniors within the group.

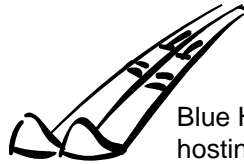
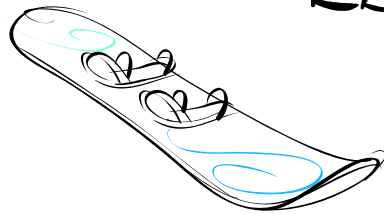


2nd Annual Fall Foliage Rides
